| BEANIES | There may be occasions where school events require the wearing of beanies on a temporary basis. |
| | Allowed if for religious or medical reasons (only <u>one)</u> . |
| BRACELETS | There may be occasions where school events require the wearing of bands on a temporary basis. |
| | Must meet Departmental WH&S standards for all Learning Areas. |
| EARRINGS / FACIAL | Sleepers are not to be larger than the small fingernail diameter. |
| PIERCINGS | Studs must be small and discreet. |
| 1 iziteites | Must meet Departmental WH&S standards for all Learning Areas. |
| FINGER NAIL POLISH | Clear nail polish <u>only</u> . |

| NECKLACE | Allowed if for religious or medical reasons (only <u>one</u>). |
| TTECKEAGE | Necklace <u>must not</u> be visible outside shirt. |
| RINGS | Only one discreet ring allowed. |
| SCHOOL SHIRT | To be worn with two buttons fastened at all times. |
| SKIRT | Black only. |
| JKIKI | To be same length or longer than equivalent size school (branded) shorts. |
| SHOES | Closed-in shoes. |
